

**CITY OF PERRY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 8, 2022**

The Public Hearing was opened at 6:30 p.m. There was no comments.
The Public Hearing was closed.

Mayor Clay McHardie called the June 8, 2022 council meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Roll was called. Members present were Mayor Clay McHardie council members Felicity Ross, Derek Aldrich, Jason Phillips and Sheri Kuenzi. Council member Issy Higgins arrived 6:41 p.m.

MINUTES

Council member Ross moved to approve the May 11, 2022 meeting minutes. Council member Kuenzi seconded the motion. Motion carried.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

Council member Ross moved to approve the accounts payable. Council member Kuenzi seconded the motion. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Wayne Ledbetter wanted the council to be reminded of the dedication of the Willkomm Trail.

Council member Aldrich moved to pass a resolution of the City of Perry, Kansas adopting and providing for standards for procurement, bidding and contract awards. Council member Kuenzi seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council member Aldrich made a motion to approve the increase in roadwork. Council member Ross seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council member Phillips made a motion to accept the final work on the sanitary sewer in the Brown Subdivision. Council member Aldrich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The council discussed speedbumps on Willow Lane. Council members did not think it would be a good idea. They asked Eugene and Tyler what their thoughts were. Eugene said it would be harder to remove snow. Tyler felt that it would not detour anyone from slowing down.

Council member Aldrich made a motion to approve a liquor license for J & K's Joint and to empower the Mayor to sign off on the license. Council member Meyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council member Aldrich made a motion to pass ordinance 823 an ordinance amending chapter IV, article 2, section 4-202 of the code of the City of Perry, Kansas regarding the incorporation of the uniform building code in the City of Perry, Kansas. Council member Phillips seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council member Phillips made a motion to pass ordinance 824, an ordinance regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the city of Perry, Kansas: amending the “standard traffic ordinance for Kansas cities: addition 2021 and all subsequent additions, by reducing the speed limit on Front St. Motion died for lack of a second.

Council member Phillips again made a motion to pass ordinance 824. Council member Kuenzi seconded the motion. Motion failed.

Council member Aldrich made a motion to go into executive session for 10 minutes for the purpose of a discussion with Eugene Dick non-elected personnel. Council member Phillips seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Executive session began at 7:10 p.m.

Council member Aldrich made a motion to adjourn. Council member Ross seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
